

I bought his book because I love to ready to my son in Spanish and he loves books. I was

disappointed this book is paper back and the quality is very thin and delicate. I have to make sure I don't let him kids play with this book as it can easily tear. If you can find one, I would suggest to get the hard cover version of this book. Also, this book in Spanish just doesn't have the same chime as the English version. Maybe some books aren't meant to be translated (although "The Little Blue Truck" Spanish version "El Camioncito Azul" is great in Spanish!)

This looks just like the original Goodnight Moon that my children and grandchildren grew up with. I sent it along with the English version to my new grandchild in Chile, who will inevitably grow up at least partly bilingual. She's only five months old, but tiny ones like bedtime stories even at that age.

I don't always love the illustrations on this book (which tend to run a bit small) but I do love the way it lends itself to the bedtime ritual with its rhymes and repeated good nights. That said, the Spanish version is just ok. Some of the words are not what I would use (in Mexican spanish) and it tends to choose words that are longer and harder for my toddler to say and remember. Other fun phrases (like the mommy rabbit saying "shhh!"in her chair) are completely removed and replaced with something less appropriate (such as "the little old lady sitting quietly in her chair"). Since we have both versions, we make our own translations but it's a bit disappointing.

As an NY born of Dominican decent, I love reading this book to my little one. My 20 month old daughter loves this book. We have both the English and Spanish versions of the book. Often times she brings her Dad or me both books to read to her. We start with one gets tired of it mid-way and then she wants us to pick up where we left off in the other language. It doesn't really matter to her which language we start/end with. We change it up all the time. I agree with some other reviewers that the translation is not exact, but the flow is very good with the changes that were made. I especially like "la viejecita que teje muy calladita" instead of "a quiet old lady who was whispering 'hush'," especially since I knit and my daughter can relate to that. Because of this book she has begun to comfortably alternate luna/moon and star/estrella. I think it's really important for my little girl to learn both Spanish and, obviously, English and this book makes it that much easier to accomplish.

I really loved the translation of this classic children's book and read it to my daughters often. The translator was able to capture the sense of the story and make it very readable and enjoyable in Spanish. An excellent goodnight story for anyone reading in Spanish to their little ones!
