

pictures have appeared on the cover of Sports Illustrated and over 40 of his photographs have graced the cover of Time. He has published 15 books, and was one of two principal photographers in TASCHENââ \neg â,¢s tribute to Muhammad Ali, GOATââ \neg ⠢Greatest Of All Time.Jim Murray was a founding father of Sports Illustrated, and sports columnist for the Los Angeles Times for 37 years. Murray was inducted into Cooperstownââ \neg â,¢s Baseball Hall of Fame writersââ \neg â,¢ wing in 1988 and won a Pulitzer Prize for Commentary in 1990. He died in 1998.Sports authority Gabriel Schechter, is the author of five books, most recently This Bad Day in Yankees History.
