

At first, I was undecided whether or not I wanted to read this. Not really a fan of sci-fi, especially with my MM romances. Because I am such a fan of Michele Notaro''s, I bit the bullet a day after I got the book....a long time for me to wait actually.Boy, am I ever glad I decided to read it. This book sucks you in from page one. Childhood friends caught up in an apocalyptic situation, friends/enemies to lovers within the first few chapters. Throw in similarities to The Walking Dead and I am all in. This is a fantastic premise and a running start to the trilogy. You will laugh, you will cringe, you will cry and you may even sob.Be aware that this ends on a cliffhanger that may make you want to throw your ereader out the window. But it is so worth it.Cannot wait for Book 2.

This book will wreck you. You will love it. You will fall in love with all the characters and you will see the hurt coming but you will cry and you will love it. It's hard to describe everything, the story is a little apocalyptic, Sci-fi? it has Romance and all the feels. I can not recommend it enough, it is just a great story. Well written, perfect pace. You will not skip paragraphs, you will not skip words. She builds this alt-world so well I swear you can see and feel it. It helps that it is all familiar and yet different.Now the hard part. I would recommend this book to anyone not just M/M readers or Romance readers, it has so much going on and is so well done.

OMG!! I would give this 10 stars if I could. How do I even begin to describe a book that covers so many different genres and makes you feel so much? This book is part Sci-fi, part apocalyptic, and part MM romance. The beginning of the book introduces us to the idea that an alien race, the Taoree, has come to Earth and taken up residence. The main group of characters revolves around three best friends: Jeremy (or J), Cal, & Nolan, along with Cal's older brother, Colton (whom Jeremy has a crush on). All four are college students and the Taoree are a pretty commonly accepted part of life. When random people start to "go crazy" and violence erupts, the four friends band together to attempt the trek from New York to Pennsylvania to home and their families. Suddenly the seemingly benign Taoree aren't so benign and the group finds themselves fleeing from both the aliens and "Ferals", as they dubb the changed humans. During their journey, Jeremy and Colton come to the realization that they are attracted to each other and begin a sweet relationship in the

midst of all the horror around them. Jeremy also dreams of a Taoree that speaks to him and seems to know him. In his dreams, this alien urges him to return home quickly because his younger brother needs him. It is upon their return home to what is left of their respective families that the book really takes off. I don't want to give away any spoilers cause you really do need to read this for yourself but I will say that our little group is joined by three more, including the mysterious Taoree from Jeremy's dreams and it also loses one. I know I am not doing justice to just how incredible this book was but mere words don't do it justice. I was completely sucked into this alternative world and read this whole book in one long gulp. I laughed, I pondered, and I sobbed without shame. I have been a huge fan of Michele Notaro's other works and was slightly skeptical of a sci-fi book in her normal genre but, boy, was I wrong. I think that this might actually be my favorite out of all her books. Please don't let the general setting of the book steer you away from giving it the chance it deserves. It still retains the MM romance undercurrent that Michele does so well but with an added layer to it. Like adding whipped cream to chocolate brownie ice cream. It's that much better. Seriously, read this book. I read this on KU but I will be purchasing my own copy as well. So worth it.I can't wait for the next two books. +++

I admit I am a Michele Notaro fan. However I am not an alien/sci fi fan. I had no plans to read this book but because Notaro wrote it, I decided to give it a shot... I COULD NOT PUT IT DOWN!! She has masterfully created an apoployptic world full of aliens, zombies (for lack of a better term) and heroes. The characters are completely engaging. The action is fast-paced, suspenseful and keeps you on the edge of your seat. I literally stayed up until 4am to read it in one sitting. There is nothing cliche or predictable. She has twists and takes risks with both characters and plot, both well constructed. She anticpates every question a reader could ask. Just when I'd start to think "well why did..." she'd answer the question for me. Beware there is a cliffhanger, but it just makes you lust for the second book. I have to say, the story took me on a bit of an emotional roller coaster ride. At one point I found myself yelling at the book. I highly recommend this book. If you don't think you like sci fi- you clearly haven't read someone that knows how to make it appeal to a broad range of readers like Michele Notaro does.
