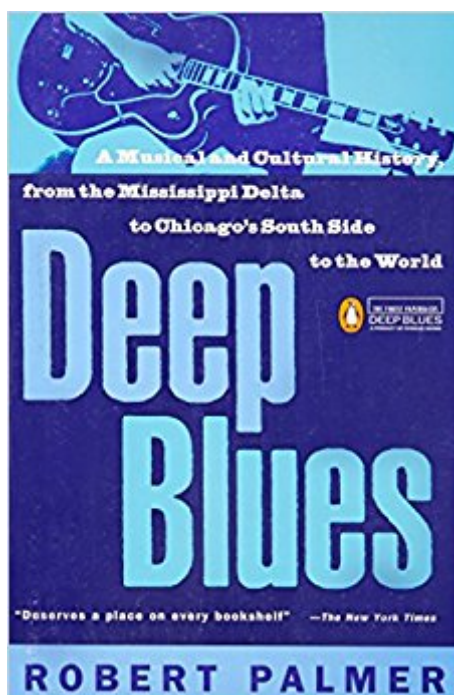

Palmer provides a judgement free history. At times the book flashes between characters and locations so rapidly that the temporal context is difficult, but in the end you appreciate the level of action the arena was experiencing. Thoroughly enjoyable, informative and enlightening.
