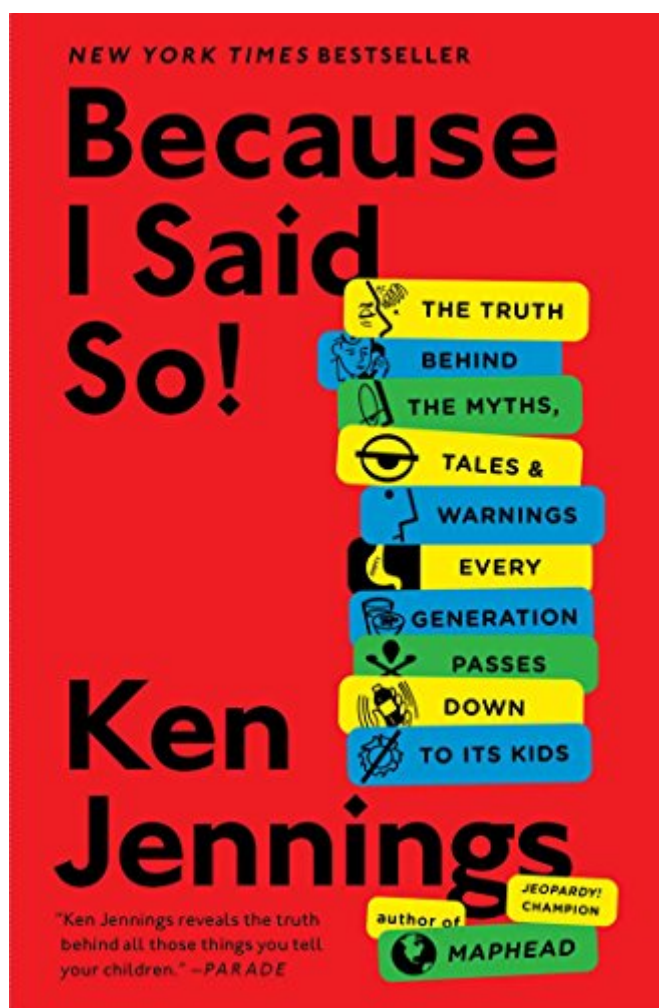

My husband is enjoying bursting people's bubbles with the truth versus myth info in this book. Add that it's by Ken Jennings and that makes it a winner.

I have not finished this book, I got bored. Not as interesting as I thought. Will finish sooner or later

... but I was surprised at the poor quality of the printed pages. I would have expected a bit of color in the "mostly true" / "mostly false" graphs at the end of each entry. Also, the pages felt a bit recycled (not that I'm against recycling). I use this as a coffee table book, so I was hoping for something a bit more substantial. I gave it three stars because I enjoyed the content.

I became a doubter of the many wives' tales I heard early in my life. But when things didn't make sense, I didn't go to the trouble of researching the answers. That's why I was delighted to read this book. Not only is Ken Jennings smart, but he has a sense of humor too.
