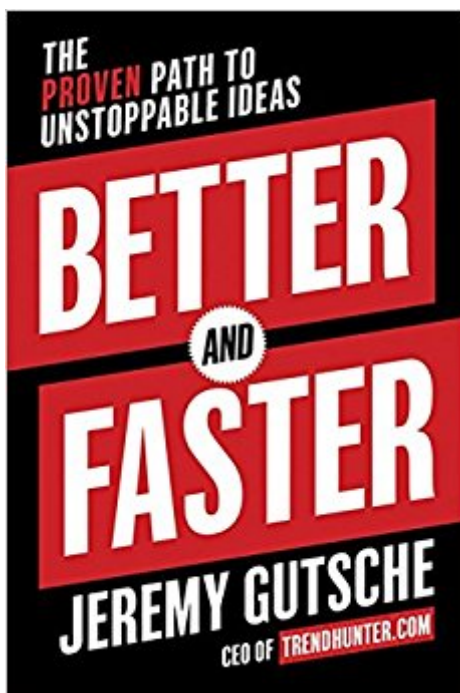

Jeremy demonstrates convincingly that if you're constantly questioning and reinventing your ideas, your products or your services, you'll have the advantage of evolving with inevitably changing interests and needs of consumers. This is an insightful read that will reshuffle your routine reasoning for the better.

This is definitely the most engaging business book I have ever read! From the fascinating and relevant stories to the concepts that are easy to understand, it is a book that can be read in one sitting. Many business books offer content that is difficult to understand unless you have formal business training or education, but this is where *Better and Faster* is different. The majority of the stories feature brands that almost everyone is familiar with -- which makes them that much more interesting -- and the concepts and takeaways from each story can be applied far beyond the business world. The book really teaches you how to resist complacency -- whether it be in your professional or personal life. A must read for anyone!

I enjoyed reading about specific companies that implemented each of the strategies. I think the trend hunter site is fascinating, and I wish that there were more content specifically around the site and the process of advising clients. I rated it three stars because while I like the stories and patterns, I was hoping for more of a structured methodology to assess/create new opportunities based on the patterns.

Better and Faster is a book that not only inspires, but gives people the confidence to think differently and take on new challenges. It's full of stories of experimental entrepreneurs who have made unlikely connections through their own experiences to come up with incredibly successful businesses.
