Richard Burton, CBE (1925  $\tilde{A}c\hat{a} \neg \hat{a} œ 1984$ ) established himself as a formidable Shakespearean actor in the 1950s. Burton was nominated seven times for an Academy Award without ever winning. He was a recipient of BAFTA, Golden Globe, and Tony Awards for Best Actor. In the mid-1960s Burton ascended into the ranks of the top box office stars, and by the late 1960s was one of the highest-paid actors in the world, receiving fees of \$1 million or more plus a share of the gross receipts. Burton remains closely associated in the public consciousness with his second wife, actress Elizabeth Taylor. The couple's turbulent relationship was rarely out of the news.
