

I have worn out my highlighters on this book! As a pastor who has studied the prophetic for years, this is the most balanced teaching on the prophetic I have ever read! Often the most misunderstood of the five fold ministry (many times for good reason and brought upon themselves), the prophet is often the black sheep. This book brings amazing clarity, instruction, accountability, and subsequently freedom to those operating under this mantle. A MUST READ for any pastor desiring to understand the prophet...and as a pastor myself, this would be a REQUIRED read for anyone functioning or learning to function as a prophet within my sphere of influence.

Refreshing and Thought-provokingFor years I have studied, engaged in, and activated others in the prophetic. Doing so gave me the opportunity to learn numerous hard lessons regarding this potent and powerful administration. Therefore, I am NOT easily impressed by much that is written on the prophetic today. Unfortunately much is verbatim and repetitive in which authors do not present new ideas, concepts, and fresh perspectives within this arena. HOWEVER, Kris Vallotton has impressed me as he intertwines Personal experiences, Biblically-supported principles, and clear passion for Prophets and Prophetic people in this text for the sole purpose of helping many navigate this administration, which is by and large still a mystery to many within God's Body. This text in my opinion is one worthy of study, contemplation, and reading time and time again, for within its pages is wisdom from someone who has clearly made many mistakes and experienced many triumphs in this arena. As such, I encourage prophetic people both young and old to consider the perspective of this respected prophet and teacher. You will NOT be disappointed

This is a well written book on the subject. The author is up front in that he understands there are various expressions of prophetic ministry around today. He clearly states this by stating he is simply sharing insights he has personally learned and that he wanted to make it clear this was not the final word on prophets or prophetesses, nor is it the only view on the subject that people should embrace. He does however begin to distinguish how New Covenant Prophets function compared to Old Covenant Prophets. This distinction is what makes this book such a gem. (This does not mean

we cannot learn or value some qualities of Old Covenant Prophets, it simply means there is a New Covenant now that is founded upon better promises and a better way of doing things.) What many fail to realize surrounding this subject is the different $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}c\tilde{A}$ \hat{a} $\neg \tilde{A}$ \hat{A} ages $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}c\tilde{A}$ \hat{a} $\neg \tilde{A}$ \hat{A} or eras in the Biblical timeline. In Jesus day, He was born into a time where, by the end of his generation, the Old Covenant was going to be made obsolete. This Old Covenant age then was disappearing (Heb 8:13) and Jesus made it clear that the destruction of the temple in Jerusalem would be one of the final signs this Old Covenant was done away with for good, as He was usher in the New Covenant based upon what He was calling the $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}c\tilde{A}$ \hat{a} $-\tilde{A}$ A "Kingdom of $God\tilde{A}f\hat{A}\phi\tilde{A}$ â $\neg\tilde{A}$ • (Gods rule with man, see Luke 12:32). We further see in the pages of Scripture and history that He was teaching a new way of understanding God and life. He was bringing a Kingdom to a world devoid of understanding the nature of God and His will for the earth and into a world where a dysfunctional covenant was about to be removed (Dysfunctional because of people not because of God). This is why he talked so much about the Kingdom of God and how it would be established in His generation and why He and his followers were to proclaim it was $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}c\tilde{A}$ â $\neg \tilde{A}$ Å"at hand $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}c\tilde{A}$ â $\neg \tilde{A}$ • (Mark 1:15). It is here where the author so brilliantly begins to give insight into the core values of the Kingdom that launch a person called to be a prophet or prophetess into a better understanding of how they are to function and operate in this New Covenant age. There are countless little points the author makes that will help people discern their callings, spheres of influence, the diversity of prophets, the difference between prophets and people who simply give prophecy and other topics that bring you into a deeper understanding of prophetic ministry. So it is with this understanding that I highly recommend this book and just as the author has stated, I don $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}\phi\tilde{A}$ â $\neg\tilde{A}$ â, ϕ t need this to be the definitive work on the subject but I do think it is a highly valuable book that will give people great insight and context surrounding the subject. It will empower and help mature prophetic communities, while

adding to the growing understanding of the New Covenant prophetic ministry that is powerfully changing the world through those who embrace it.

Kris Vallotton has written an incredible book for those called to the office of a prophet, and also those with a desire to function in higher level prophetic ministry. This book is unlike any other book out there on the subject of the prophetic in that it isn't an explanation of how the gift works, but an injection if core values that should shape how a new covenant prophet should function. Deviating from the prophetic models of the past that focus on doom and gloom, Kris paints a powerful picture of what a prophet should look like: a hope bearer. We're not called as prophets to become a commentary on the evil going on in the world, but instead we're called to gaze into heaven, perceive the blessings of God, and then release them into the most dire and hopeless of situations. This book is one of a kind and has changed my life, I highly recommend that you buy it and add it to your personal library.
