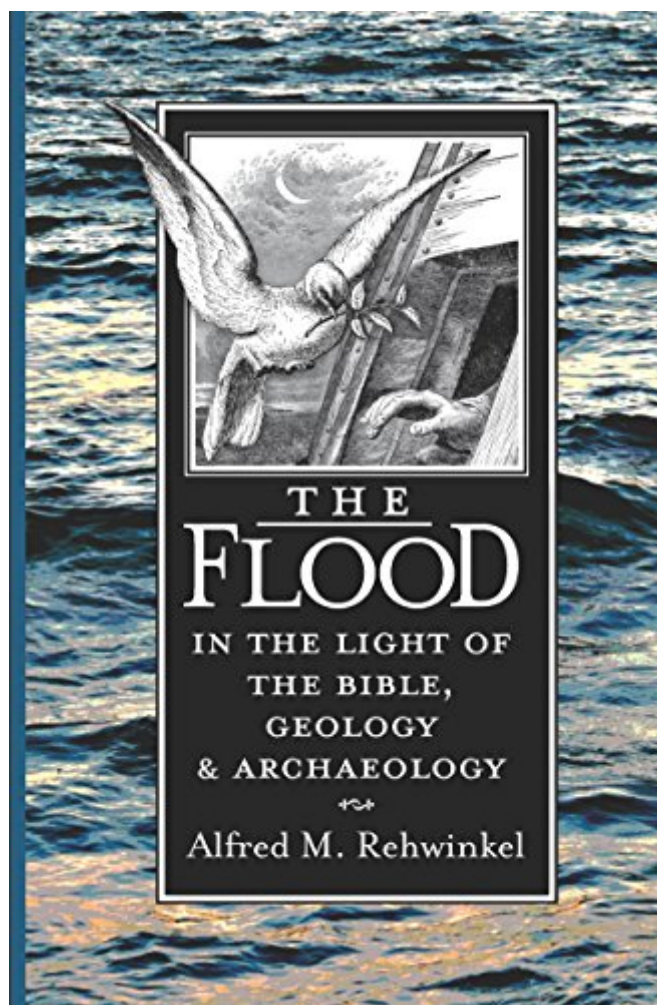

This older book still holds relevance for today, as the author takes scientific fact and makes a strong case for the it being consistent with Biblical truths. Rehwinkel is a compelling author who states his case clearly and forcefully. Those who depend on secular interpretations of science will likely see this as "Creationist drivel," and therefore not read it, but sill have lots opinions about it, while fundamentalist Christians may feel they already know this. I would recommend it to both.
