

It is good for beginners who are looking for a more sophisticate art of cutting paper and the ideas in the book lend themselves easily to those who would combine calligraphy with the art of cut paper for weddings

and announcements.

It gives you a good launching point for experimentation, as well as many different projects to do as-is.

Items in this book can be used as gifts or gift tags, invitations, and something out of the ordinary to brighten someones day. Great book. clean, clear, concise instructions.

True to Japanese aesthetics, the techniques and projects presented in this book are beautiful in their simplicity. This does not mean that all the projects are easy to cut. The freehand paper figures by Keiko Tsuji, who suggests the incorporation of characters in scraps of printed media into lively designs, require excellent visualization and manual dexterity skills. The Bluebird and Christmas Tree mobiles by Yoshiko Murayama, require accurate x-acto knife cutting skills. However, what I liked best about the book, is that the authors encourage exploration and originality of design. In addition, the beautiful applications suggested, such as collage, screen printing and ornaments, can make marvelous gifts. Happy cutting!
