

In addition to having served as a pastor and then a Professor of Practical Theology at Westminster Theological Seminary in Philadelphia, Dr. Adams has been the Dean of the Christian Counseling and Educational

Foundation, Laverock, Pennsylvania, since its founding in the early 1970s. He has written over fifty books, translated the New Testament into English (The Christian Counselor's New Testament), and lectured throughout the world. I also read his original book over 10 years ago and bought this edition because the other one never made it back to me after I loaned it out. The corrections he made were outstanding and makes this book even more valuable. It is written to cover Matthew 18:15-17 and it is done both biblically and simple in its presentation. There is so much unbiblical understanding in this area that I would recommend every minister to read this book to see how their views lines up. The highest recommendation I can give is that I have used his material and his triangle of incremental steps in 3 churches and all have become healthier as a result. In one church there was a terrible problem with gossip that had taken over the atmosphere of the church. This teaching not only cleared the problem but no one was lost in the process. What I especially like is how the congregation/members are empowered and released to care for each other as they become proactive in creating and maintaining healthy, Godly and biblical realtionships. The most interesting possiblity is how a spouse can utilize this process to better their marriage.

The content of this book is excellent. The quality of the printing is hard to read, and scattered throughout, at least half a dozen pairs of pages were stuck together so that I had to separate them carefully without ripping them.
