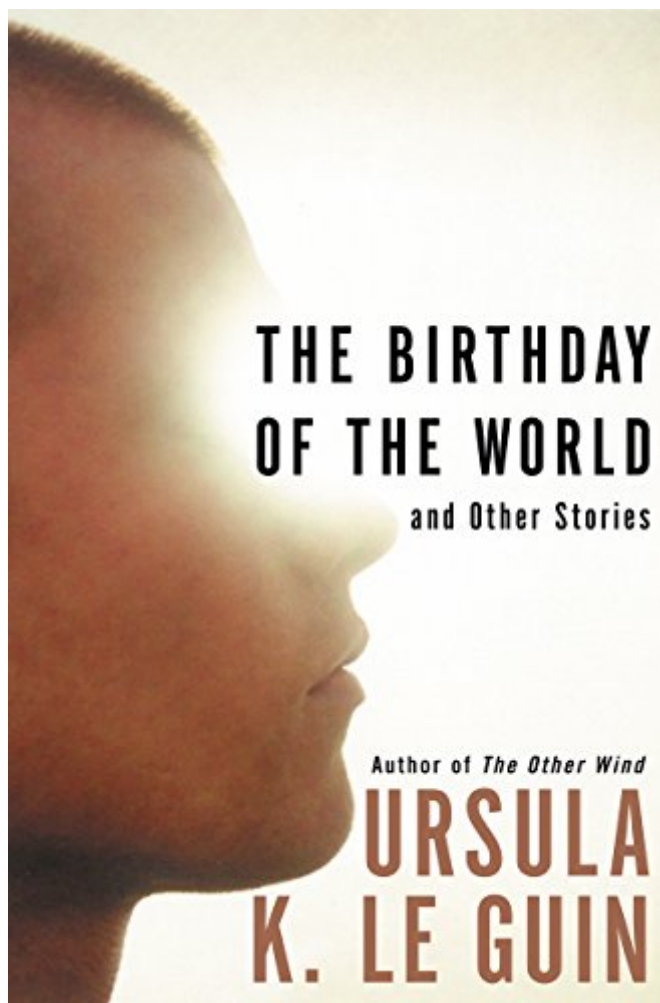

I don't know why I stopped reading her. But I saw this collection on sale relatively cheap and thought I'd give it a try. What a costly mistake! All the stories in this collection had merit, but the novella of the title was especially refreshing in its depiction of a generations journey to another world. I found it fascinating. I love it when an author forces me to think without banging me over the head with a hammer. The mistake? Now I will have to go back and purchase her other works. She was ahead of her time. Maybe not a mistake, but costly as she has written quite a few books. I look forward to the journey.

Ursula is a premier writer of science fiction and takes liberties. Most of them wonderful. Most of the stories in this collection describe civilizations of varied but plausible multi-sexualities. In many ways, this is enlightening, has a beauty to it, and challenges (straight) humanities bi-chotomy and dichotomy. Her worlds are painted lovingly. Many of them have languages that are interspersed with the writer's English narrative. These languages are sibilant and have lovely sounds to them. My one complaint: If inventing a lovely speak, there is absolutely no place for the F-banger. NONE! But it is repeated and repeated and emphasized throughout a whole section of the galaxy. SHAME!

A series of short stories most of which are based in worlds created by the author in other novels. Mostly explores multiple, partnered marriages and cultures derived from. Interesting concepts that quickly grew old after the first couple of stories. The last entry was about a generational starship and how the people adapted. I found this one tedious and boring. I can't recommend buying this. Read it if it is free, but not worth the time otherwise.

I was quite disappointed. Most of this was purely sexual. Not what I had hoped for in the least! Not to mention they were very vulgar.
