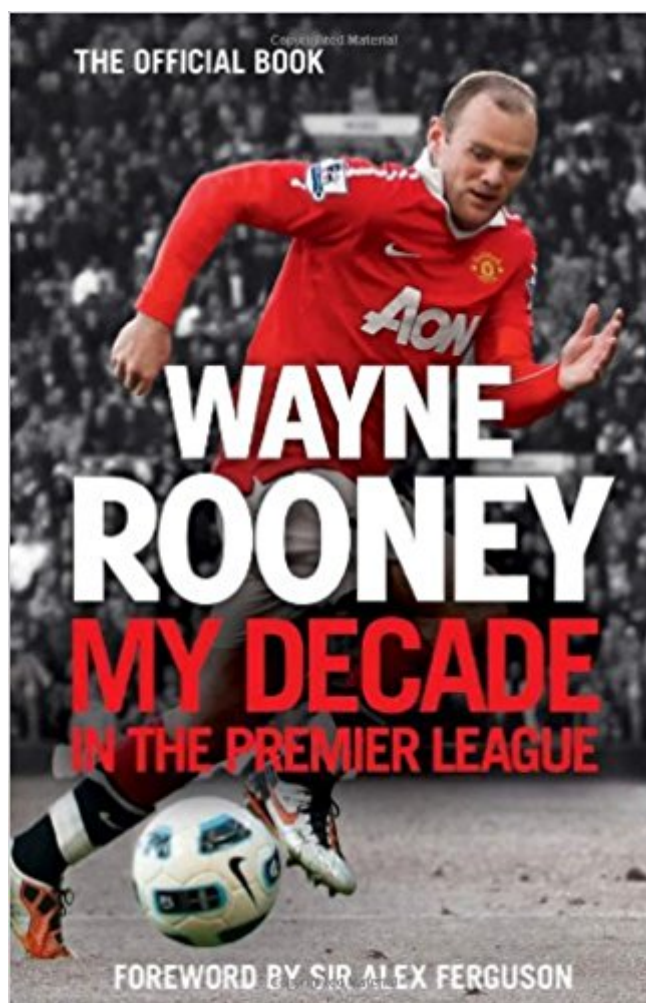

Wayne Rooney was born in Liverpool in October 1985. He became the youngest scorer in Premier League history in 2002, at the age of 16, shortly after making his debut for Everton. In August 2004 he joined Manchester United for a fee of GBP30million and has gone on to become their highest ever scorer in the Premier League. He has won 4 League titles and the 2007-08 Champions League in addition to numerous FA and League Cups. He is widely regarded as one of the finest players of his generation and is, undoubtedly, the most talked about player in British football.

As a Manchester United fan, I really enjoyed this and could barely put it down. He comes across very well overall. He covers quite a few topics from his transfer request to his hair transplant. He gives a lot of insight into the day to day life at MUFC, what the training is like, how injured players get treated, the build up to a match, the attitude of SAF and the kind of things he says to motivate the players and how he felt in certain situations (and his reasoning for feeling that way) etc, etc. The language used is very conversational as you'd probably expect, he says a lot of stuff like something "does my head in", or something else is "dead good". That isn't really a bad thing, but may not be to everyone's liking. I prefer that it is written as is, rather than the message being lost. He just comes across as an ordinary lad, who just happens to be insanely talented and passionate about football. If

you are a Premiership fan or in particular a United fan, I would highly recommend this book.

Autobiography of one of the top strikers in the Premier League. In Wayne's own words, read about his formative years as a young lad in Croxteth, Liverpool, and his meteoric rise to the EPL, becoming the youngest player ever to score in the Premier League. He glosses over his Everton years, with most of the book concentrating on his service with Manchester United. Some interesting facts and anecdotes regarding his teammates, manager, and his family, but the majority of the narrative is focused on individual matches throughout the course of these ten seasons. The book becomes a tad repetitious when relating match summaries, and there isn't near as much behind-the-scenes insider revelations as I was expecting. I was hoping to read more inside information about what goes on in their lives off the pitch, but there were few examples to be seen here. FWIW, I'm generally neutral regarding Rooney and ManU...neither a diehard fan nor do I dislike him (or the team). Overall, I'd recommend it for Rooney fans or ManU fanatics, and it's not a bad read for the casual football follower, either. But I felt it could have gone a little deeper in some areas.

Still the best, no doubt ! What a vision in the pitch, great scorer, record breaker, what else ? now in partnership with Zlatan we can only expect the best. A decade in the Premier League tells it all.

It's wonderful to read Wayne's 10 years in the premiership, for me and I'm a Man Utd fan, however I found myself getting a little bored, it was just lacking 'something' I'll give it 4 out of 5 stars but only because I'm a united fan, it really warrants 3!

I've always been a big fan of Rooney, and this book just made me that much more of a fan. I like all the different topics he touches base on and all of the details he goes in to. It is written very conversationally, but I think that makes it that much better. A first person account and real thoughts of his time in the Premier League.

Personally this book contained information which I already knew. But reading through it refreshed my memories on how we used to dominate the EPL and how we were on a roll in the Champions League when CR7 was a ManUtd. I know Rooney's career is going through a tough turn and hopefully we will get to see him finish his career as a Red Devil.
