

I had to read this book for a promotional exam. After reading the book several times, I came to the conclusion that the 319 pages of reading material could have easily been edited down to about 150 pages without losing anything. The book is extremely wordy and repetitive. I kept saying to myself, "Yeah, you already talked about this same thing in three other chapters." The book includes the words "leadership" and "ethics" in the title but 90% of the book has little to do with these topics in a practical manner. I'm very glad I will never read it again.

This book is a nightmare to read. He should have read his own chapter on report writing (concise, to the point, not excessively wordy) and used it for the rest of his book. Unnecessarily wordy (I shouldn't have to stop and use a dictionary to understand what you're trying to say) and overly

lengthy drawn out sentences. Footnotes constantly interjected into the middle of paragraphs make it impossible to follow. Ever heard of an appendix?, or that footnotes belong at the foot of the page, which is why they are called footnotes. I doubt either of authors have any legitimate police service time or experience to call themselves "experts" either. A book written by politicians for politicians, not for the police.

I bought this book for testing purposes for my lieutenants test. It was on our required reading list and I felt the book was a tough read. There were several times I wasn't sure what the author was trying to convey so I had to re-read the paragraph over again. Some of the concepts were new and some were a review of things I had learned about in the past. I put quite a bit of effort into this exam but came up short so I have to wait and see what's going to be on the new list for the next test. Hopefully I will have better results.
