

I first read this outstanding work over 40 years ago. At that time there were not many books of its type available. For its moderate size I thought it was the most comprehensive, thoroughly Biblical, practical, and experimental book on the subject of the Holy Spirit and His work that I had yet seen. Since then, many other books of its type have been published. In my own experience it was particularly useful in establishing me in a non-charismatic, non-pietistic direction. It avoids all the extremes of subjectivism yet is warm and devotional and will be spiritually edifying to anyone who reads it. So why, after all these years, am I reviewing it now? First, I gave my first copy to a Bible

teacher who I thought might benefit from its balanced treatment of the subject, and it was never returned! I replaced that copy. Now, in the Kindle age, I purchased it again to make it readily accessible as I carry about my Kindle library of helpful Christian books. Despite the many other books about the Holy Spirit which can now be obtained, I would still recommend this one highly.
