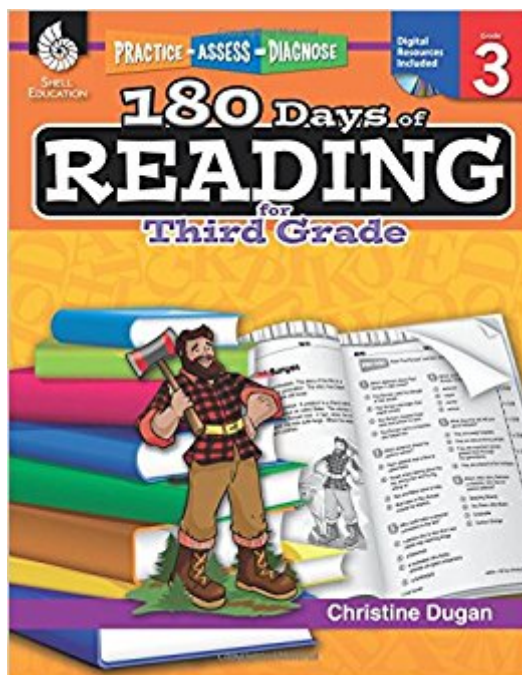

Very good daily practice. Look through the weekly assignments' focus and take them out of order to better align with your lesson sequence.

I recommend the book for those kids who need extra work and whose parents are not of great help due to a language barrier. They can give their kids a task pulling out the Answer sheets out of the book first and make the kids do the task, say 5 tests at a time on a daily basis. They can finish the book in one month that way and definitely make a progress.

This worked really well with our 8 yr old who was struggling a bit with reading comprehension. He does a worksheet every evening and we review them on Fridays. His audible reading and comprehension have improved dramatically! We will be purchasing the 4th grade version for next yr!

This is a great resource for daily practice with my students. It gets them thinking and it has allowed me to have great discussions for comprehension purposes. Thank you.
