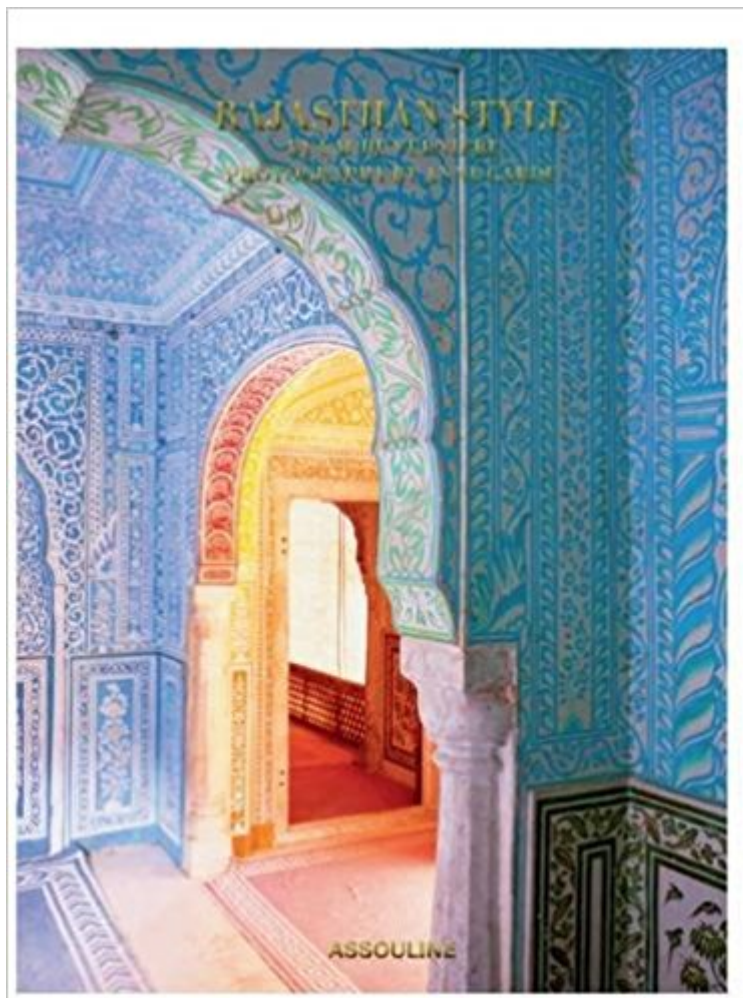

Garde's literary collaborator, Vernière writes the texts for Garde's photographic works. Together they have produced two previous travel journals: *Japan Express* (Le Seuil, 2003) and *Pondicherry Masala* (Le Seuil-Le Théâtre des écrivains, 2004). Vernière also creates multimedia artworks combining Polaroids, visual poems, collages, repurposed objects, and paintings, which she exhibits in France and abroad.
