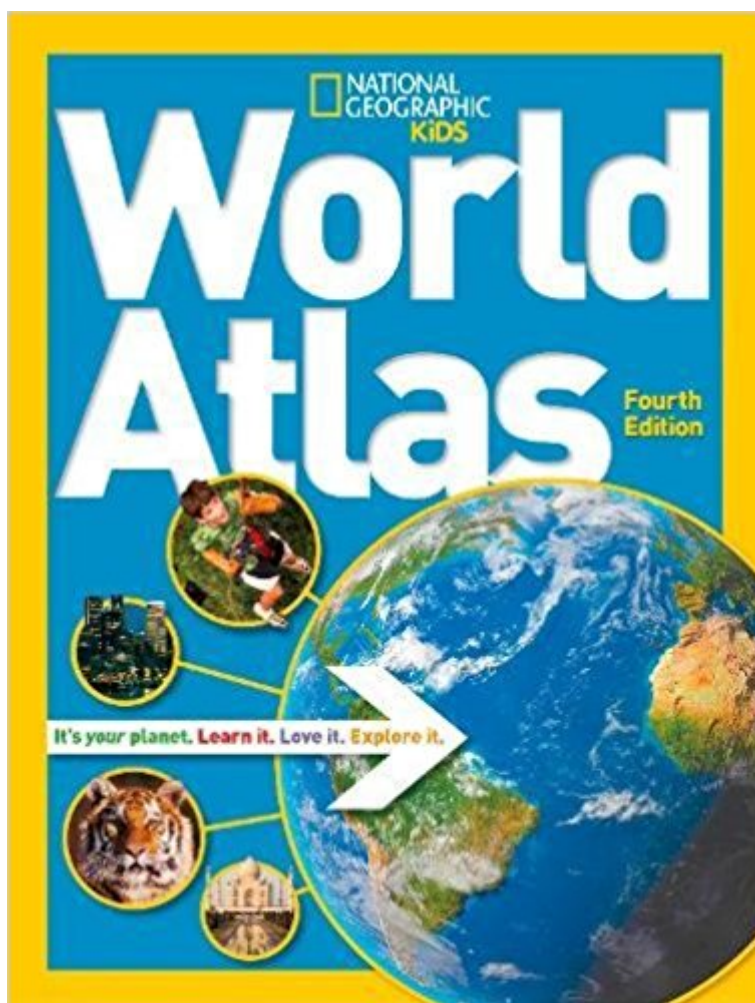

I like the atlas, but with the lightweight paperback cover it makes it very difficult to use. We have a hard time getting it to lie flat and have to hold the pages constantly. When you are working with an atlas sometimes you need to be able to lie it down flat without holding it. We've worked around it, but I wish it had a heavier cover. We usually have to sit something on the edge of the pages to hold it down. Overall good atlas though.

My daughter loves this atlas! She was reading it all weekend. Not only does it have maps from all over the world , it has fun activities for kids and interesting facts about a variety of topics. It was very reasonably priced. I'm very happy with my purchase!
