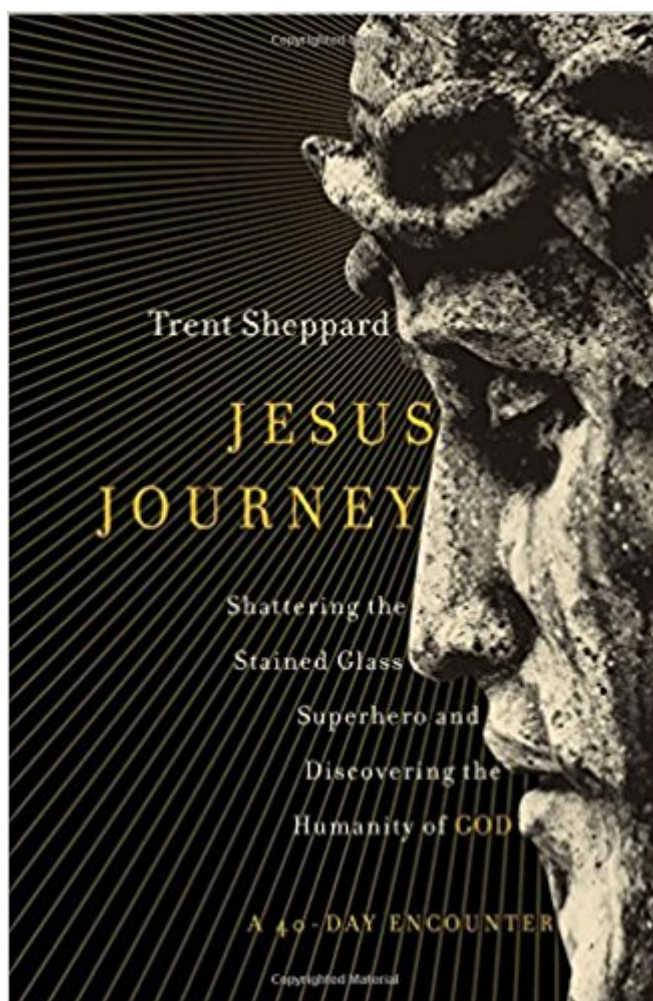

Well, I have to confess it, it only took me a couple of weeks to read through this delightful and deeply moving book; not the 40 days suggested. But I can see how powerful it might be to slow down and take just a Ã¢â¬â“dayÃ¢â¬â at a time to read it because it is a journey in itself. I love that the chapters-- each covering a significant event in JesusÃ¢â¬â, s life-- are very short, and so relevant to the way we live and think now about what that life was all about. What should we think about him now? What can we think about him now? We may very well still be mystified by the divinity of this extraordinary man, but itÃ¢â¬â, s his ordinary humanness that has been captured here: his in-the-body feelings, in-the-moment humour, and in-the-heart compassion such as any of us may want to feel or express, or would want to see in a brother or a close personal friend. Leavened with some of TrentÃ¢â¬â, s own experiences within himself or with his family, he beckons us to follow on the journey with some delightful humour, too, spilling from his lightly-held pen. You want to drop

everything and just be on the journey with this Jesus, a journey that is absolutely NOT the tired old facts of a biblical account, but a person very much present in the world we are living in now. How much do I Love Trent Sheppard's book? Well, I just finished it last Thursday and on Monday I started it again as part of the author's group reading for Eastertide, the 40 days between the Resurrection and the Ascension. My first reading was done one day at a time for the 40 days of Lent as well as in concordance with a full reading of the KJV New Testament. I also used the KJV to check the scriptural references in each chapter, some of which are from the controversial interpretation The Message by Eugene Peterson. As a Southern Baptist, I've learned to be prepared to defend anything that is not directly from Scripture. I found all references to be accurate and completely in line with the KJV scriptures. To me, the fact that Jesus was fully human and that His divinity was revealed through His humanity has always been where the crux of my faith had resided because that's where the hope is, that's where the faith is. If Jesus was/is fully human and we are also, imagine the possibilities of what we can do with our faith. This book brought me to tears every morning and drew me so close to Jesus that there were literally times I could, with the help of the Spirit, feel His physical presence in the room with me. If you have an open mind and an open heart for Jesus, read and experience Him through this small volume and draw ever closer to the One you've been in love with for years!!

Being raised in a Christian home and hearing the stories of Jesus' miracles and perfect life on what seemed like a daily basis, it has always been hard for me to believe that Jesus could really understand my struggles. Because of that, I read every book I can find on the humanity of Jesus and each one seems to impact me in a different way. Trent grabbed my attention early in this book when he pointed out in such a graphic way the stigma that Jesus carried with him throughout his life; illegitimate! And I thought the stigma of being a preacher's kid was tough; people would apologize for cursing, friends didn't want to sit with me at lunch because I prayed before I ate, boys would say we can't talk about girls with him here (that one hurt!). All of a sudden it hit me; Jesus does get it. From that point, Holy Spirit just seemed to keep talking to me as I read through the interesting perspective that Trent gives to some of the most familiar stories in Jesus' life. I fell in love with the most important man in history all over again. We have so much in common. I had planned on spending the suggested 40 days to read Jesus Journey but got so taken in that I read it in 2 settings. I know this book will impact your walk with Jesus in a positive way.

This book will change your life. Jesus Christ will become so clearly understood.....you will want to read it more than once. I devoured this wonderful book and bought several more copies for my friends and family, then recommended it to many more. Trent's humor and transparency about his own experiences, make this book so fun and deep at the same time. I had both tears and laughter.
