It's been a while since I read book that really made me not want to put it down. While reading Moonburner, I got mad every time I had to stop reading and get back to real life. Then I spent much of my time thinking about what was happening in the book, what I thought would happen next, and strategizing for when I could get back to my Kindle. That's how great this story is!The plot is fresh and original, he characters are well-written and relatable, and the writing is so smooth and effortless that I could envision everything that happened without having to go back and reread parts (which happened to me a lot when I read fantasy, particularly with newly-created words).The pace is perfect and the dialogue is wonderful, particularly between our main character Kai and her seishen, Quitsu.I give this book a very enthusiastic 5 stars, and I CAN NOT WAIT for the next book! Claire Luana is a very talented writer with a great career in her future!

My highlights:1) The world in Moonburner is built effortlessly, giving me the background of what is happening in a natural way. I did not read boring paragraphs telling me the past. Rather, I learned everything throughout the natural flow of the story. Very hard to do (in my opinion).2) The world/plot/characters/history... pretty much everything... was VERY unique and refreshing! Ms. Luana's creativity shined through this book. The detail of the Moonburner world was up there with the top fantasy books I've read.3) Kia is a likeable and realistic protagonist. Moving with her through

her journey made me feel as if I really knew her personality. She grew from a lonely girl to a strong young woman. Absolutely loved seeing the transformation.4) While the story started a little slow, it quickly picked up and I eagerly turned the pages to find out what would happen. After the first "book", the plot moved at a quick pace. So if you start reading and feel like the story is slow, I recommend pushing through the first few chapters. It is worth it!My only complaint would be it took too long (for me) for the romance between Hiro and Kai to come up. I wanted it to happen from the first interaction. But that's just me being impatient, lol :). The romance was written very well. I really enjoyed the progress there.Overall, I recommend this read for fantasy readers.
