

Useful and practical information not found in other pubs like the FAA's Helicopter Handbook. The mountain flying portion alone is worth the price of admission, because it provides valuable information and techniques for understanding and operating in varying wind and terrain conditions. Other than the brilliant work of the Canadians in British Columbia, no one has put this out for pilots who need the tools to fly effectively and safely in the mountains. I know, because I spent the last 25 years of my aviation career teaching and evaluating helicopter operations in the mountains, as a pilot, instructor, and FAA Inspector. This concise, easy to navigate book is a gem. Get it. Study it.

And learn to take advantage of the winds and the terrain before they take advantage of you. Fly safe!
