

It is so nice that there are still places in this world where people are not jaded by advertisers and

huge egos, where a person's word is their bond, and forgiveness is given freely. Of course, trust does not just automatically follow forgiveness, nor should it and it doesn't for Verity although she gives hers more quickly than I would after six years of betrayal. I like reading Samantha Price stories because her characters demonstrate and struggle with the same thought processes I do...maybe not about romance in particular for me but the example transfers to life in general. I find it easy to overlook the repetition in her stories because that is what people do until they gain mastery over their thoughts in any trying circumstance. I do believe her novels would benefit from a much more attentive proof reading before publishing; but if you want a light and encouraging read that will give you sweet dreams, try Impossible Love..

I've read a few Amish works of fiction lately. I like the fact that they're clean and have happy endings. Beyond all that, this book helped me do some grieving, as it reminded me of experiences I had when I was young. I think it would have been good for Verity's emotional journey to recognize and accept her share of responsibility for what went wrong between her and Reuben. ***Spoilers Ahead.*** When she asked the Bishop if her expectations of Reuben were reasonable, instead of simply answering, "Yes," he could have brought up the fact that she had chosen to be courted by and become engaged to a guy who would have been the first to admit he was not yet a grown man--spiritually, even if in no other sense, and in their case his lack of spiritual maturity turned out to be pivotal. I see tremendous healing power in incorporating one's acknowledgement of one's own share of the responsibility in the process of forgiveness. In fact that's an acknowledgement she could have made at any time irrespective of what he did, and I think it's kind of sad to suggest otherwise, as if Verity were in a prison of Reuben's making entirely instead of acknowledging she was in a prison at least partly of her own making.***Spoilers continue*** I thought that the about-face each of them did at different times in desiring a reconciliation was a little abrupt, although I can understand why. Reuben's about-face especially was abrupt since we didn't get to see the process by which he arrived at dumping his Englscher life for his former Amish way of life. I would have liked to see a little bit of his process. I've read much more expensive books with less enjoyment. Not only did I enjoy the book, I found it enriching for my life!

I always learn something new when I read a book regarding the Amish culture and I did with this one also. This is a story about a young Amish woman whose boyfriend went to make his fortune and was to be back home is six months...well it took him six years to return to the Amish community he had left. The young woman was bitter and unforgiving regarding his promise to return sooner.

She had not dated other men waiting for him. He finally did return because he received a letter saying his mother was in the hospital...which she was NOT. Short version is man and woman get back together and forgive. get married and hopefully live happily ever after. My book was downloaded onto my Kindle from ..if you want an easy read with only happy ending, get this right away.

This was a good story about forgiveness and second chances. I was glad Verity stood up for herself. I ached for her and all that she had gone through and was going through. I didn't connect with Reuben. I felt like he was almost a side character. I would have liked to hear a little more about his journey back to God. This really was Verity's story about learning to forgive.

GREAT! I can't imagine that Verity waited 6 years for Rueben to return. Faith couldn't stand to see her sister, Verity, so sad all these years and wrote Rueben (how did she find him in NY) that his mother was in the hospital. Rueben, of course, accused Verity of doing it and she had no idea until Faith admitted it. You really never get the sense that Rueben is going to return to the Amish community, but he decides and he does it; then he pursues Verity. It is a good love story.

A really good story that stresses the importance of forgiveness and the importance of not being bitter. I liked this story so much and could really empathize with Verity.

Read this great book in 2 sittings. Beautiful and interesting story of how a young woman finds love at last. Samantha Price is a great author. I really enjoy the quality of her writing.

I always enjoy reading Samantha Price's books and this one was no exception. I liked Verity and felt so bad for her when Reuben finally came back and didn't believe her about writing a letter saying his mother was in the hospital. At that point, and when Verity found Reuben with his ex-fiance (even though he said there was nothing between them), I didn't like Reuben very much. Only after he changed and realized that his life was in Lancaster County did I start to see why Verity loved him so much and believed he would come back. I also liked the secondary characters, especially Old Red, the dog.
