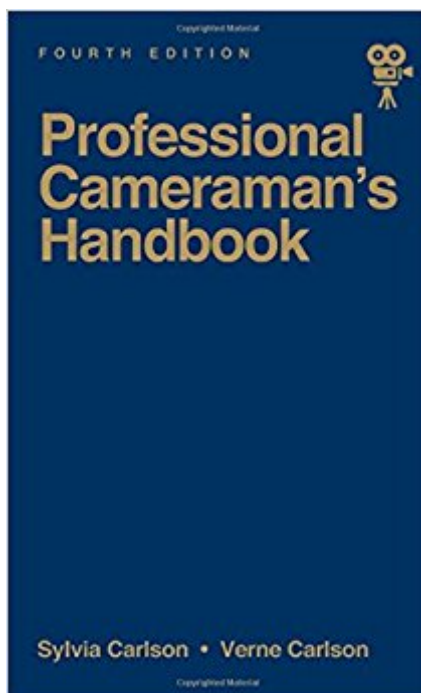

This is an essential reference for professional cameramen, and an insightful book for those who want to see some of the "nuts and bolts" of how a cameraman works. Lots of detail, and extensive discussion of specific cameras and their use.

Because it hasn't been updated Professional Cameraman's Handbook is missing some newer equipment, but it is the best source for information for pre-1994 camera equipment. I'll buy the 5th edition as soon as it is available.
