

Clementine takes charge and takes no prisoners! I loved the dynamics between Clem, Kisho and Nic. The snarkiness between Clem and Nic has me laughing out loud; while the relationship is so charged with sexual tension. One thing that I liked about this series versus Anita Blake Series is although there were sexual tensions like for instance when Nic was disciplining Kisho it was tastefully done. I highly recommend this book.

I do so love smart mouthed, kick butt female heroines. Who would have thought a demon huntress with a sassy attitude and a super secret power would team up with a motivational vampire? Maybe pigs can indeed fly? Join Clem and this motley crew as she fights demons and tries to take down a vamp that even the vampires can't take down...
