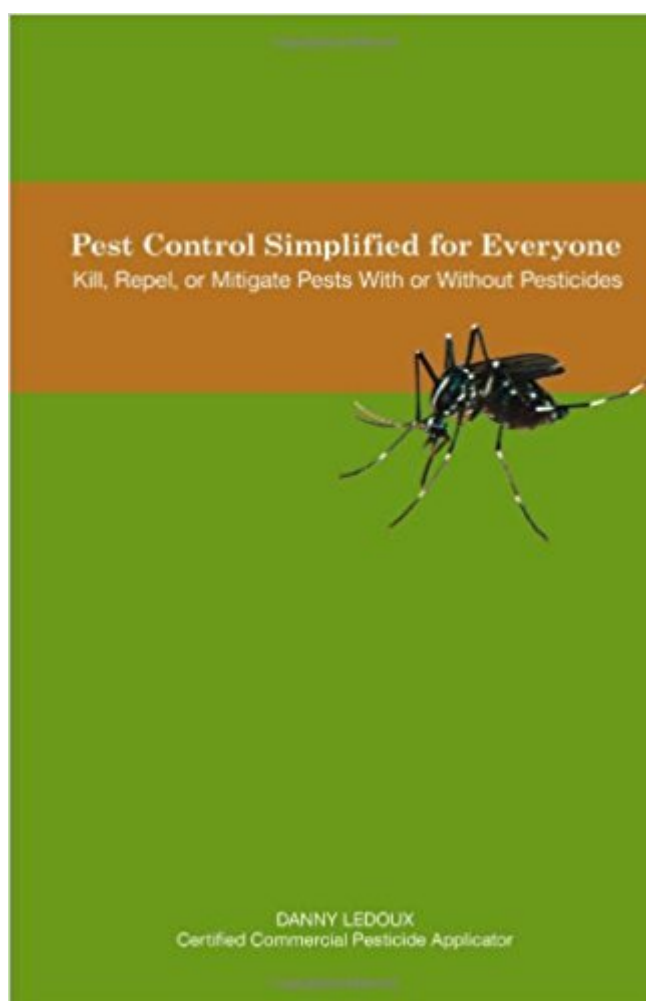

I thought this book was good for a general understanding of pest control for an individual homeowner. Although for a very specific problem more details are available for a higher priced manual.

I think more than anything, that this book can provide a person with the confidence to face off against any pest that may inhabit their living space. This book does not hold your hand and pat your back with the fine nuances of the matter, but rather it provides a good broad base understanding of the why and wherefore of the complicated plethora of chemicals in the battle against pests.
