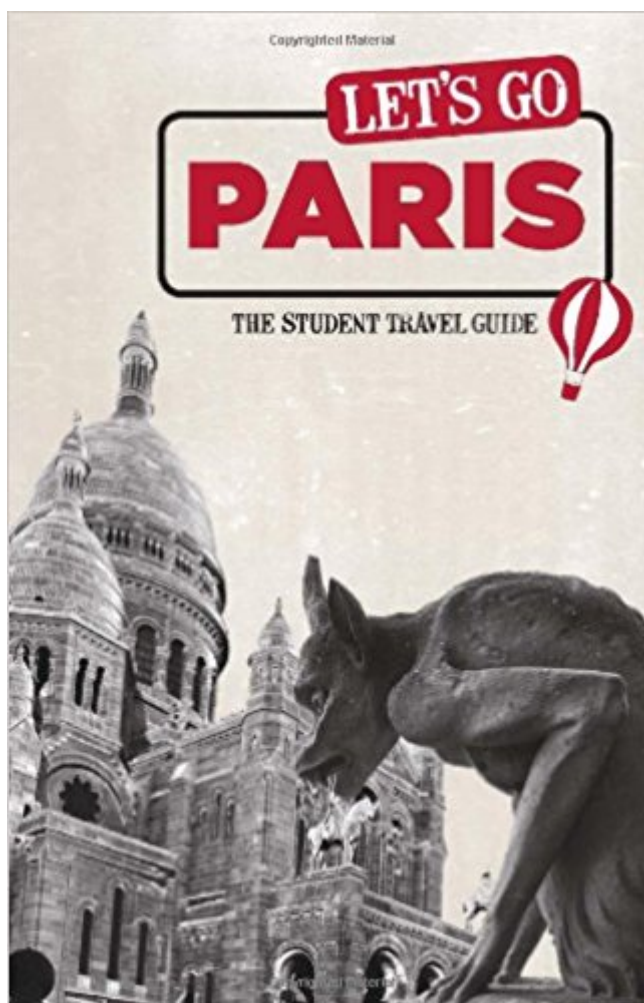

## Customer Reviews

As always, the "Let's go" series is good but for some reason this one needs some visit to rewrite this Paris guide.

I've never been misled by the info contained in this book. The restaurant reviews are "spot-on". This is an essential book for the budget-minded traveler. I wouldn't go to Paris without it.

I am an old Let's Go fan. I took my first copy of Let's Go Europe with me backpacking through France in the late 70's, so perhaps the writers of Let's Go Paris have passed me by. That said, I can't believe the contrast between the book published in 2010 and those of just 10 years ago when the mission was to reveal how to do expensive Europe on a student's (and now teacher's) budget.

This is not true for the entire Let's Go series. I used Let's Go Spain last year which really did offer help on budget travel. The problem is with the suggestions on eating out. Perhaps naming a few grocery stores is enough to appease the unwashed masses of us who do not want to spend more than 40 dollars on a meal. I know Paris and I know London well enough to find some really remarkable restaurants that don't break the budget. Many of them are found in Let's Go Paris and Let's Go London guides from before 2004 or so. I would suggest that the editors of Let's Go examine their mission and decide if it really is a budget traveler's guide or notes for kids on a splurge.

I've been a dedicated Let's Go user since my first trip abroad in 1982. I've used USA several times, France, Paris and others. The Paris guide is a deep disappointment. They've removed reference to the year in the titles, so you have to be a sleuth to figure out how old the info is. I bought mine in December 2010 to later realize that it was written in 2008. The metro information is outdated and there's no metro map, the index was frequently absolutely WRONG, and it didn't have current information about renovations of major museums. What was once a great franchise is now a disappointment.

Poorly edited - the index and table of contents are wrong in so many instances it makes it laughably pointless. Buy any other book on Paris. Avoid this one!
