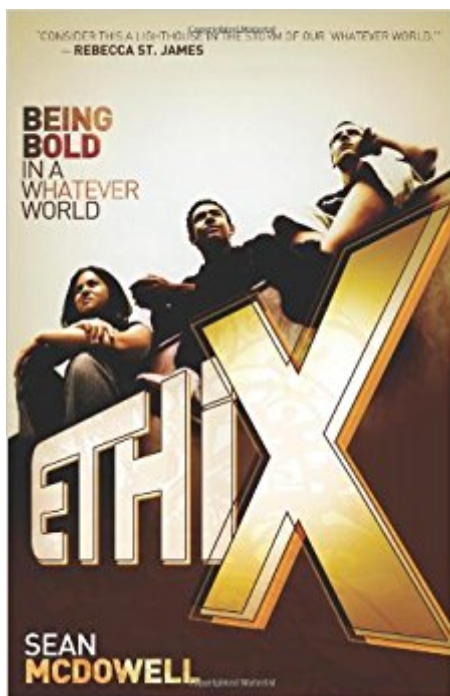

Dr. Sean McDowell leads the Bible department at Capistrano Valley Christian Schools in California. The awarded teacher is also a popular national youth speaker, editor of the HCSB Apologetics Study Bible for Students, and has authored several books including *Understanding Intelligent Design* (with William Dembski) and *ethiX: Being Bold in a Whatever World*. Sean and his wife have two children.

This book makes plain things one would think should already be plain, but aren't. It's a great book for teens and adults alike. For me, it explained a lot of the belief system that's been pawned off on our young people. Whereas before I was just scratching my head, now I think I begin to get it. It still doesn't make sense to confuse facts with preferences, but at least I see in part how the lie has been sold. Would make an excellent basis for a youth small group or Sunday school class, or even a youth group series. Everyone who cares about kids, especially including kids, should read this book. If you have pre-teens or teens, make every effort to read this book with your kids. My daughter (16) enjoyed it very much.

Issues such as sex, drugs and alcohol, and moral relativism are what Sean McDowell deals with in this readable and well-researched book. But this book is more than just a bunch of facts thrown together. It's relevant material from a nationally known youth speaker, and I think the sincere Christian young person who is looking for answers to real issues is going to find it to be a big help. With objectives listed at the front of each of the 11 chapters and study questions placed at the back of the chapters--including group study questions--all youth pastors should immediately begin a weekly study with their teens. There is so much at stake that we need to quit babying our Christian youth and start providing answers for real world questions. After all, they are introduced to reality much earlier than my Baby Boomer generation was. As a Christian high school Bible teacher, I predict that a book like this will provide

some important answers to these thirsty souls, and so I give Ethix my endorsement for Christian youth and their parents everywhere. I hope this will not be the last time we hear from the sharp apologetic mind of Mr. McDowell.
