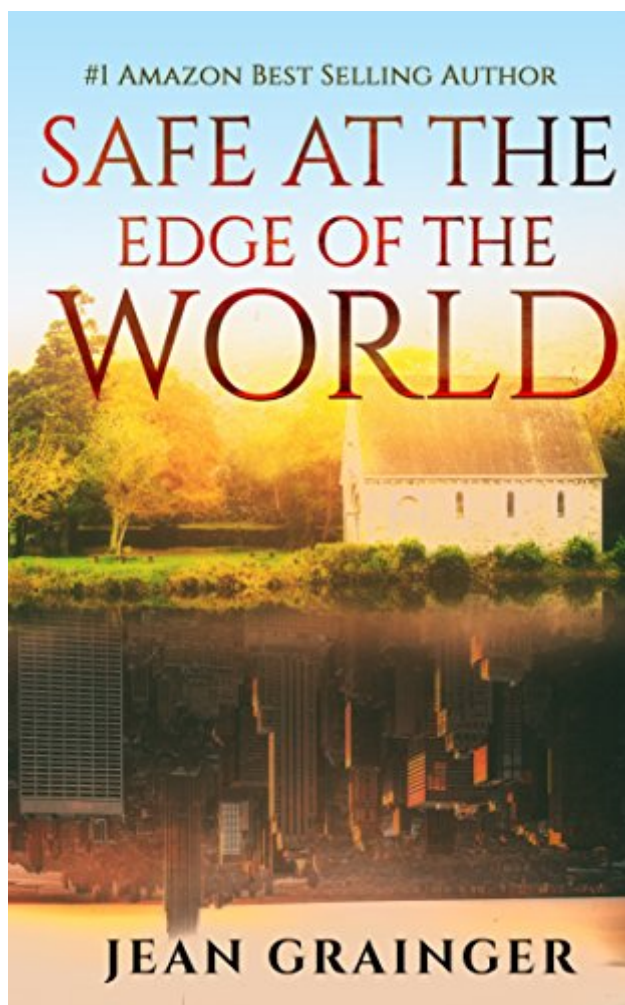

There are side stories in addition to the main plot that keep everything moving along nicely until the story heats up. The plot became more intense than I expected. I anticipated some developments, but even so, just seeing how everything played out was exciting. Overall, I enjoyed this book very much and hope that there are more Tour stories to come!

I appreciated the characters and their dilemmas. I was a little disappointed in the the priest's epiphany and the fact that he didn't cry out to God for a solution from the beginning. I expected a deeper, more real faith. But I thoroughly enjoyed the ride.

I was very disappointed. Had thought it would more closely follow the lives of the characters in The Tour. Rather, she introduced a new couple and their dark Mafia ties. The original was a fun and uplifting read; the sequel was heavy and depressing. Guess I'm in the minority, but I did not enjoy the book.
