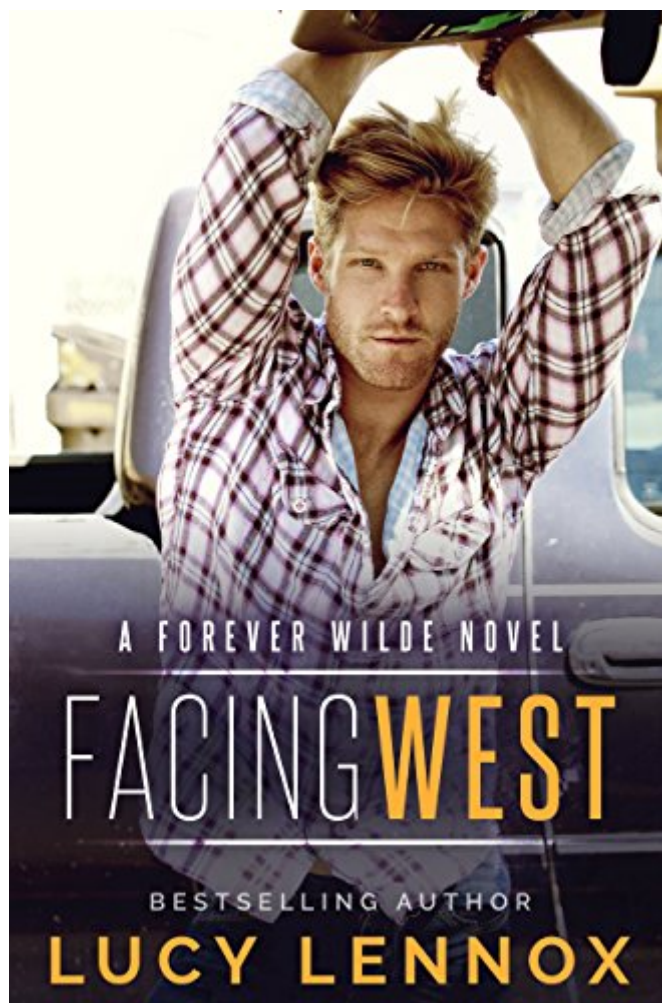

Synopsis

Weston: There's one thing I know for sure about Nico Salerno: he was a good-for-nothing as a kid and judging by the purple-haired, tattooed punk who shows up at his sister's funeral, he hasn't changed. There's no way I'm letting him take custody of my best friend's baby. But the more time I spend around him, the more I realize that his rough exterior is just a shell and that beneath all the tattoos is a scared, insecure man searching for a place to belong. And pretty soon I know exactly where he belongs: in my bed and by my side. The problem is, he abandoned his family once before, how do I know that if we become a family he won't do it again? Facing West is the first in the new Forever Wilde series about the huge Wilde family from Hobie, Texas, whose patriarchs aren't above a little meddling if that's what it takes to help their grandkids find true love.



He runs to San Francisco thinking it was *the* place for gay men/boys. Sadly he found out quickly, harshly, this isn't truth by any means. Weston comes from a huge family full of siblings, loving parents, Grandparents and extended family. Every dream he had ever wanted has come true, except finding a man in his tiny town in Texas. Fast forward fifteen years. Sadly Nico gets a call saying his sister has died and left him as sole custodian of her baby girl. Nico has never really been much for children and is ready to move forward, offering her up for adoption. In a cruel twist of fate, his sister has named Weston as the biological father before giving Nico guardianship if she passes, plus her bakery and house she worked so hard for. No one knows why she has done this. Nico decides it's best to leave West to sign Pippa over for adoption to the "town's golden couple" (there is a huge twist there too!!) and takes his life back to his tattoo shop in San Fran. Time will only tell how this ends up. Scared, Nico finds himself in love, but feeling he'll never be enough for West. He left to give his mother and sister a better life, it's what he needs to do for West and Pippa as well. West sees past Nico's walls and does his best to show not only does he love Nico, but Nico does have a huge, loving, extended family, if he truly wants it. This book ties into characters from the Made Marian books and a few pop over into this story as well.

Lucy Lennox has done it again with the debut book in her new series. I've been hoping for Nico to get some love ever since we were first introduced to him in the Made Marion books. His journey toward love and acceptance certainly doesn't disappoint. West is the perfect balance of family, love,
