

Excellent book! For those of you who haven't seen any equations or math problems for years, this is an excellent refresher. It explains and teaches you how each problem gets solved as well as prepares you to what you should expect to see in the Asvab. My scored improved by 30 points after studying from this book.

#### Great condition

This is the most incomplete study guide I have ever seen. It asks you test questions which are very often not even covered in the pre-study sections of the chapters. In addition, it leaves out key formulas in the study sections, and, particularly in math and physics-related questions, they often times leave out the key steps in order to properly solve the problems (in the answer explanation sections following the practice questions). Basically, I feel like I have been ripped off of money AND time by getting this book.

This book did a wonderful job preparing my daughter to take the ASVAB to join the US Coast Guard. It helped her in areas where she had limited knowledge such as mechanics and electrical engineering. She scored the highest score on her testing date and was able to join the coast guard without any problems.
