

Totally Disappointed. This is nothing more than a regular French dictionary, and a bad one at that. I will be asking for a refund. If you already have studied French and want a real Quebecois dictionary, this is not it. How very disappointing!

Worst ever, it is just a French book, no Quebecois terms. Do yourself a favor and just search the internet and not order this book.

I purchased this phrasebook because I will be doing a bicycle tour in Quebec this summer and was

looking for a phrasebook I could easily carry with me. It is very comprehensive and won't be easy to carry with me and offers much more than common translations. So for my needs its more than I needed.

If you can speak French well, but were taught "France-French," you may at some point find yourself testing your French with a trip to Qu $\tilde{A}f\tilde{A}\odot$ bec. It will probably be a real eye-opener, as the accent is massively different, and many of the words and phrases used there are also distinct from the French you were taught. When you get home, you may search for a book like this one to help you retool your French for La Belle Province. This is not the one you want. Its second biggest problem is that you don't want the book to teach you French, you want it to teach you a regional dialect, and it spends far too many pages teaching you words that could be used in either place (and makes no distinction, either, so you'll need to wade through everything to look for the words that you know you don't know...). I've also found that its coverage of ordinary words I know are used in QuÂf©bec is not complete. Its biggest problem is its sketchy description of the Qu $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}$ ©b $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}$ ©cois accent--which is a far worse barrier than not knowing what a giggle you'll get if you use a phrase that sounds old-fashioned or frou-frou in QC. Any good "dictionary" should have a pronunciation guide that's clear. That is not here. The accent is the major reason to need such a book, but the topic is barely glossed over. Did the authors not know? Now, if you speak little French, perhaps this book will be of use to you. But if you speak little French and feel you can learn from a dictionary, I'd recommend getting a comprehensive French dictionary over this--because as a \*French\* dictionary, this slim volume doesn't cut it at all.

You are way better off buying the NTC Dictionary of Canadian French. This book is just too short for me.

I love the concise, clear instruction in this book. I just wish there was a complete language course for the study of the Canadian French language.
