

Dramatic color photographs, including the collapsed section of the Bay Bridge, a bulldozer demolishing a severely damaged apartment building, and an abandoned teddy bear sitting amid rubble, emphasize its severity. Simple explanations of the San Andreas fault, the Richter scale, scientific progress in earthquake prediction, and the difficulties experienced by agencies attempting to provide shelter and transportation for the suddenly homeless add to the books value.
