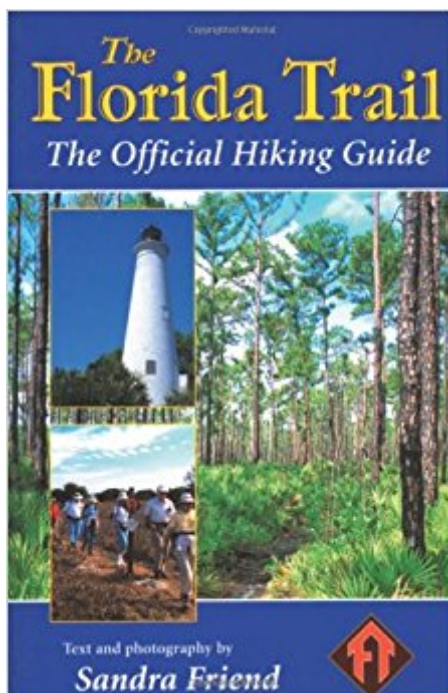

This book is a most for everyone in Florida, whether living in Florida (in which case, GET OUT OF THE CITY!) or visiting. It has great reading, photos, and other great information.

Having recently moved to Florida, I ordered this book and it has ben very helpful in finding good hiking trails for my wife and I.

After hiking the Florida Trail in 1995 from the southern terminals at Hwy 41 to the Georgia border when the official guide was a photocopy and better than nothing for a great adventure, today I opened Friend's guide in anticipation of hiking the trail again. I am sadly disappointed that this is the worst guide I have come across in 30 years of hiking the Vermont, Colorado, PCT, and sections of

the APT trails, plus the length of Baja, California. I don't know where to start. The unlabeled trail section descriptions are haphazardly placed throughout the book. The maps have no mileage key. The main map is at 4x4" is so tiny and w/out detail as to be useless. The manuscript is disorganized as if done in a hurry, and the layout is really so terrible that it cannot be understood without about two hours study. Sorry, but that's the facts. The guide gets one-star for the shiny Florida Trail decal bookmaker.
